Budget:

District is taking \$125 per student enrolled.

We still get SB178 funds so we did not lose 9 teaching positions. We have 5 open positions right now plus we will be receiving roll over money.

We are not going to lose any staff members, due to budget money coming in higher than expected.

On count day we were 100 kids short.

Losing a Counselor because numbers are too low. Team voted to keep counselor and pay for it out of budget rollover monies.

Losing a Special Education CC teacher because numbers are too low. Team voted to keep teacher and pay for it out of budget rollover monies.

Losing a Gen Ed teacher because numbers are too low. Team voted to keep teacher and pay for it out of budget rollover monies.

Team voted to add an English position and hire a long term sub.

Team voted for the following support staff positions to add an extra hour a day to make the 8 hour employees.

- 2 campus monitors
- 1 social worker

Team voted for the following support staff position to add an extra 2 months.

- SBT
