### **Active Learning:**

- Will also allow for a hybrid component (100% training provided).
- Next year we are expecting all schools to have a face-to-face component and a full-time distance learning cohort.
- Additionally, the district wants a group of schools to pilot active learning (PBL).
  - School will be supported to be a community socio-emotional center for both students and parents of the community.
  - Pilot will use the Buck Institute for PBL training; CCSD will provide up to 100% of the training during the summer for all staff.
- The Korda partnership will not start until August.
  - *6 Volunteers to date; Principal will send out another request for volunteers tomorrow (20 April 2021) per recommendation.*
  - Will take two teams of two and an administrator through a higher-level active learning scenario about how to bring community problem-solving into PBL
  - Will support us through December of next year.
  
- Our partnership with Korda will cost us about \$14,000 – for a full semester, four courses, five people.
- 1<sup>st</sup> round of training in August – Online ONLY.
- Future trainings up in the air (online or in-person)

Question from Betsy - Any update on whether or not teacher assistants will be eligible for district training?

Roxanne – Not sure, still pending clarification.

Question from Rosalia - Can my 6th grade child attend Summer School at Jerome Mack Middle School?

Roxanne – There are two answers. So, I say “YES”.

Question from Karen - Can my 8th grade child attend Summer School at Jerome Mack Middle School?

Roxanne – Absolutely; eighth graders can not attend High School yet.
