1. Betsy Gillis nominated by Cynthia Daniels and voted unanimously to continue as President of Jerome Mack SOT

Cynthia Daniels nominated by Gail Garrett and voted unanimously as Vice President of Jerome Mack SOT

Jordan Cooper nominated by Betsy Gillis and voted unanimously as Secretary of Jerome Mack SOT

All voted in favor of going out of order of Agenda set 9/20/21.

2. SPP Road Map Review: Christina Murray-Baker presented the SPP plans being brought to the CCSD Decision Committee for Mack Middle School Student Success Plan. Following the current plan as previously submitted Mack Middle School has shown increased performance in SBAC testing and continues the recommendation that Social Emotional Learning needs to continue. Current School MAP testing projections in English and Math are to increase 6% in Math and 22% in English the current goal being to increase by 50%.

Question/Comment: Betsy: Kids did not show improvement over the last school year.

Conclusion: Accurate proficiency on MAP testing improvement not received due the last semester of school being completed by all students at home.

Key Programs discussed to further increase testing proficiencies and overall student performance: Carnegie Math instructional rounds, WIDA, ELD, HOPE, Panorama Student Survey

New Program to be Piloted at Mack Middle School Introduced by Roxanne: Hazel Health Tele-Health school program. It is an opt-in online health program to offer to the community for easy non-emergency medical help.

The goal is to have involvement of 10% by spring 2022 of the Mack Middle School Community.

Question/Comment Betsy: We want parents to see Mack as a resource, how are we going to measure this involvement?

Conclusion: Continued Panorama Surveys for students and District Surveys for Parents

Survey to take place in March- tentatively the 3rd for the school year.

Changes made to SPP to be submitted:

- "Field Trips" to "Field Class" or "Field Experience"
- Staff 48% minority changed to "staff to mirror diversity of school community"

3.4 Final Budget and resulting staffing

Mrs. James said that there was a change in the final budget amounts and stated that the school had more money than anticipated because the district changed the amount of money that the school was required to pay per teacher. She said she would provide all the details at the next meeting. Mrs. James also said that with the additional funding that was available she was looking to purchase additional computers. Betsy said that the SOT had previously approved the purchase of a number of computers and recommended that additional purchases be approved by the team. Mrs. James agreed that additional purchases be discussed at the next meeting as it was not listed in the current agenda. Mrs. James also said that she would be asking teachers for their "wish list" for what they needed and would bring that information to the team during the November 29th meeting for discussion. She also said that she would be talking about purchasing a floor stripper for the custodians to assist them in keeping the new tiles clean.
